## REF CALLS

 <b>BACK OVER</b> Right arm at right angle to body giving a left to right motion.	 <b>DELAYING THE GAME</b> Both arms extended out to the side with fists closed.
 <b>BOARDING</b> Pounding of the closed fist of one hand into the open palm of the other hand.	 <b>DELAYED PENALTY</b> Referee extends his non-whistle hand straight up until the end of play.
 <b>BUTT-END</b> A cross motion of the forearms, one moving under the other.	 <b>ELBOWING</b> Tapping either elbow with the opposite hand.
 <b>CHARGING</b> Rotating clenched fists around one another in front of chest.	 <b>FACE-OFF</b> Arms crossed in front of the chest, hands open one behind the other. Pull arms apart as if resembling two sticks being drawn.
 <b>CROSS CHECKING</b> One forward motion with both fists clenched extending from the chest.	 <b>5-SECOND COUNT</b> Whistle hand extended straight over head with 5 fingers apart.
 <b>FREE HAND CHECK</b> Left arm extended with open palm facing outward showing a pushing motion.	 <b>FREE HAND CHECK</b> Left arm extended with open palm facing outward showing a pushing motion.

 <b>MISCONDUCT</b> Placing of both hands on hips.	 <b>10-SECOND COUNT</b> Both arms extended to just over your head with 10 fingers apart and extended.
 <b>ROUGHING AND UNNECESSARY ROUGHNESS</b> Extending one arm out to the side with closed fist.	 <b>TRIPPING</b> Both feet on the floor, right leg forward and keep looking straight forward as knee is being struck.
 <b>SHOT ON NET</b> Whistle hand extended straight up, rotate index finger and bring arm down.	 <b>UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT</b> One hand on top of the other to form a "T" at the side of the body.
 <b>SLASHING</b> One chopping motion with the edge of one hand across the opposite forearm.	 <b>WASH OUT</b> Both arms swung laterally across the body with palms down. Goal disallowed.
 <b>SPEARING</b> A pushing motion with both arms as if pushing the stick from the stomach.	 <b>WRAP AROUND</b> Crossed arms in front of your chest with fists closed.

 <b>GOAL CREASE VIOLATION</b> Place one foot on crease line and signal possession while blowing whistle.	 <b>HOOING</b> One tugging motion with both arms, as if pulling something toward the stomach.
 <b>GOAL SCORED</b> Both arms extended over your head.	 <b>INTERFERENCE</b> Crossed arms in front of chest, hands open.
 <b>HAND BALL</b> Show clasp of hands together at waist level.	 <b>KNEEING</b> Tapping one knee while keeping head up.
 <b>HIGH STICKING</b> Holding both fists clenched, one above the other, at the height of the forehead.	 <b>MATCH PENALTY</b> Tap on top of head.
 <b>HOLDING</b> Clasp either wrist with the other hand well in front of the chest.	 <b>MINOR INTERFERENCE</b> Forearm across chest, then point in direction of possession.
